

## Florida PTA Opposes HB 7069

Late on a Friday afternoon in early May a massive education bill was introduced in the State Legislature through the budget process. On the following Monday it passed both houses.

This bill was negotiated behind closed doors, bypassing the democratic process of public input and the option for amendments. While testing reform, daily recess, and other good education policies have been placed inside this bill, it has a devastating impact on the education budget that will leave our most vulnerable children behind. It will likely have noticeable impacts on our students at John E. Ford.

It is now on Governor Rick Scott's desk for his signature into law.
